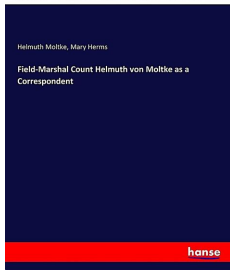

Helmuth Karl Bernhard Graf von Moltke (German: [ˈhɛlmuːt fɔ̃n ˈmɔltkɛ]; 26 October 1800 – 24 April 1891) was a German field marshal. The chief of staff of the Prussian Army for thirty years, he is regarded as the creator of a new, more modern method of directing armies in the field. He is described as embodying "Prussian military organization and tactical genius."
