The bottom log should be at least 12 inches above the ground. The roof at both the eaves and gable ends should be long enough that rain does not hit the log walls except in wind-blown storms. My gable ends extend 2 feet from the log walls. The eaves extend 36 inches horizontally beyond the log walls.
