The Gathas (/ Ē^ Ē; Ē'Ē• t Ē™ z, -t Ē'Ē• z /) are 17 Avestan hymns believed to have been composed by Zarathushtra (Zoroaster) himself. They form the core of the Zoroastrian liturgy (the Yasna). They are arranged in five different modes or metres. The Avestan term gĀ•Ī, Ā• (ō•-”ō•-•ō•-šō•-• "hymn", but also "mode, metre") is cognate with Sanskrit gĀ•thĀ•Ī• (à¤—à¤¾¾à¤¾¾à¤¾¾), both from the Proto-Indo ...
