In Islam, ziyara(h) (Arabic:  $\text{ﺯﻳﺎﺭﺍﺗ}$  â€Ž ziyÄ•rah, "visit") or ziyarat (Persian:  $\text{ﺯﻳﺎﺭﺍﺕ}$  â€Ž, ziyÄ•rat, "pilgrimage") is a form of pilgrimage to sites associated with Muhammad, his family members and descendants (including the ShÄ•Ä• ImÄ•ms), his companions and other venerated figures in Islam such as the prophets, Sufi auliya, and Islamic scholars.

A shrine (Latin: scrinium "case or chest for books or papers"; Old French: escrin "box or case") is a holy or sacred place, which is dedicated to a specific deity, ancestor, hero, martyr, saint, daemon, or similar figure of awe and respect, at which they are venerated or worshipped. Shrines often contain idols, relics, or other such objects associated with the figure being venerated.
